

ANNUAL REPORT 2018 – 2019

Academics :

This year 38 students appeared in the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) of the Central Board of Secondary Education.

Gagandeep kaur topped the school and stood first in the Commerce Stream with an aggregate of 95% marks. Even she became the **Tehsil Topper**. Anshika Baranwal stood second with an aggregate of 88% and Nikita Vishwakarma stood third with 86% and subsequently for others the percentage of marks is as follows :
Sumandeep Kaur 82%, Sukhdeep Kaur 81%, Shivangi Bhasin 79%
