Academics :

This year 37 students appeared in the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) of the Central Board of Secondary Education.

Navneet kaur topped the school and stood first in the Commerce Stream. Followed by Khushnoor Ahmed, Tejveer singh, Parth singh, Navpreet Kaur and so on. We feel proud of such type of students

The All India Secondary School Examination of the CBSE was appeared by 88 students.
